Understanding our anti-harassment policy

EO is a harassment-free environment

Harassment related to race, citizenship, gender identity and marital status is NOT acceptable and violates the Code of Conduct.

Sexual harassment is prohibited

What is sexual harassment?

Sexual harassment includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Offensive and unwelcome sexual invitations or comments
- Unwelcome and unnecessary physical contact of a sexual nature
- · Harassment by member to staff, member to member and volunteers.

Complaints process

Notify leadership if you are a victim of harassment.

Investigations

All harassment claims will be promptly investigated by Human Resources if it involves staff, or a governance committee member if it involves members. Members and staff found to have violated EO's Anti-Harassment Policy will be subject to discipline.
